History of Compliance

Office of Disability Affairs (ODA)

The ODA and the Commission on Disability Affairs (CODA) are established

Americans with Disability Act Amended

State and local governments required to update pre-existing Transition Plans with an emphasis on program accessibility

1990

Americans with Disability Act (ADA)

The ADA becomes law and BOC passes resolution making a strong commitment to ADA compliance

1992

Original Transition Plan

County creates 1st transition plan with a focus on facility accessibility

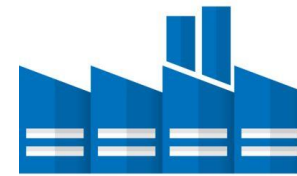

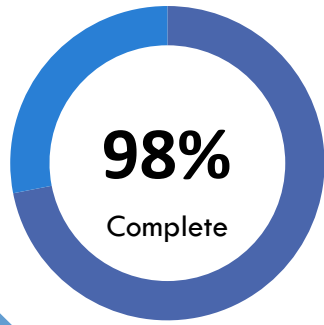

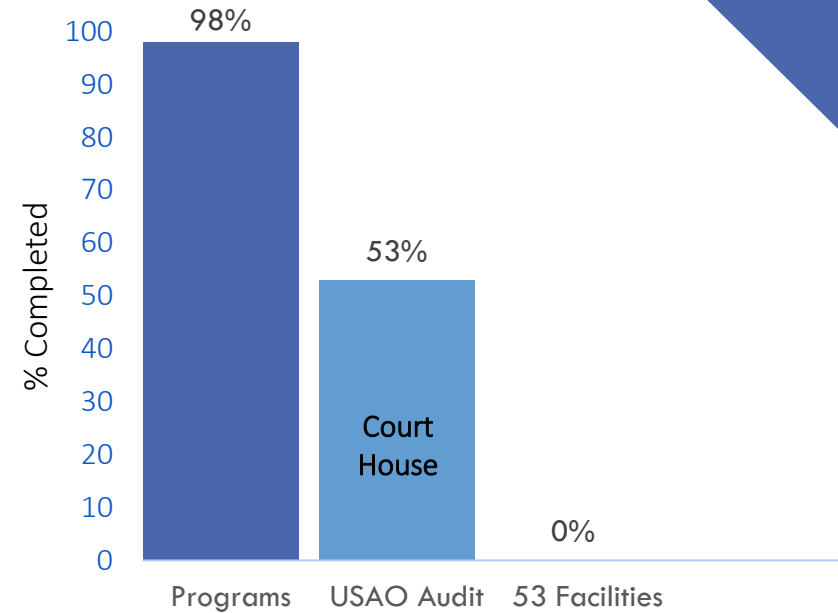
