This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and **modifies** the original RFP documents as noted below:

- 1. Question:** Your Police Interceptor specification calls for color keyed carpet and color keyed floor mats. This is unusual in patrol cars since rubber mats and vinyl seats are much easier to clean. Please let me know if carpet is what you really want.

Response: Interceptors should be equipped with cloth front seats, vinyl rear seats and vinyl mats all the way through. Administrative units will need color coded cloth seats with matching carpet and floor mats as described in original specs.

Referencing Compact cars

- 2. Question:** Full size spare tire is not available. May we delete this item?

Response: Yes, delete it.

- 3. Question:** Cruise control is not available on the base Focus. To upgrade the model and add cruise is over \$900.00. Is this something that you need on this car or was it just in an old spec? It is available aftermarket. Is this mandatory or can we delete it?

Response: Delete it.

Referencing Pick up trucks:

- 4. Question:** Your spec calls for "step type bumper and running boards" What sort of "running board" do you require? May we delete this requirement?

Response: No, do not delete. We require factory installed step tubes, steps, bars, running boards, or equivalent. Running boards or steps will be needed on all 4-Wheel Drive units and all trucks 250 or 2500 series and larger for safety reasons. These type trucks have a large ride height and can be hazardous during entry and departure.

- 5. Question:** Your crew cab spec calls for 245/70RX19.5 tires. This tire is for a larger truck and not available on this truck; may we substitute LT265/70R16E tires?

Response: That will work until you reach trucks in the 450 and 550-model size. Models over 550 require 245/70RX19.5.

- 6. Question:** The specified fuel tank is specific to certain pickup beds and not available on all models. May we ask that you substitute "standard fuel tank"? **Response:** That would be fine.

7. **Questions Regarding the Equipment On The Trucks.**
Question: CLASS 5 - UTILITY BODY- WHAT LENGTH?
Response: No less than 9' (feet) not including bumpers or rear work platforms.
8. **Question:** CLASS 5- AERIAL LIFT- BODY LENGTH, AERIAL BUCKET REACH, AND CAPACITY
Response: Body length of not less than 9'-10' (feet) will be sufficient. Minimum Aerial Height of 35' will be needed. Minimum weight capacity no less than 320 lbs.
9. **Question:** CLASS 6-7 UTILITY BODY LENGTH
Response: Minimum body lengths of 11' up to 14' not including bumpers or rear work platforms.
10. **Question:** CLASS 6-7 BOX TRUCK CARGO LENGTH?
Response: Minimum length of 16' and maximum not to exceed 24'.
11. **Question:** CLASS 6-7 FLAT BED DUMP BODY LENGTH?
Response: Not that critical, existing truck in fleet is 12' and 14' either will suffice.
12. **Question:** CLASS 6-7 WATER TRUCK- CAPACITY?
Response: My understanding is that the minimum should be 900-1,000 gallon.
13. **Question:** In section 3-19 you call for 15 prisoner transport vans and 1 medical Examiners Body Transport Van. Do you have spec for 1 ton cargo vans, interiors, and prisoner cages?

Inmate Transport Units

Inmate Transport Units will have two (2) high volume circulation fans that replace the interior compartments air five times per minute.

The seats are fully covered with 3-M skid resistant film for safety.

The floors are made of heavy-duty .125-gauge treadbrite aluminum.

Doors are approximately 1 1/4" thick with .125 mill finish aluminum skin over both sides of a 1" rectangular aluminum square tube to create a sandwich-type secured construction.

Units will have an approximate 8"x20" Lexan window for visual control.

Stainless steel "Piano" style hinges for maintenance-free opening and closing.

The rear and side doors are secured with two (2) -each key-lockable T-handle actuated anti-burst slam locks.

Each lock has a 6,000 lb. bursting strength. There is no access to any door lock from inside the unit.

All interior lights and fans are installed with a convenient switch control panel.

Units to be shipped are complete with all electrical items pre-installed.

Rear step is included with each unit.

The side step is included with all 3-compartment models.

Each step is made of .125 gauge treadbrite aluminum for an anti-slip safety.

Inmate Units are will be equipped with Side & Rear Loading and 3 Compartments.


All surfaces are cleaned and sprayed with a bed liner type material that is scrub and steam clean resistant.
