ADDENDUM NO. 1 Request for Proposal – 08RFP64017C-MT Scrap Metal Removal Fulton County, Georgia

Dear Vendors:

This addendum is in reference to 08RFP64017C-MT
Scrap Metal Removal

1. In my effort to pinpoint a price I've noticed that there are several unforeseeable variables. The main ones being: - How much of what metal & at what rate will be removed.

Response: We don't know what will be scrap metal until items have been designated surplus to Material Control.

2. How much is the recycling worth for a specific metal at a given time.

Response: Rates are set by the Metal Industry, and not the County.

3. To reduce some of the guesswork, it would be ideal for me to take a look at the work sites & determine roughly the amount of which materials will be processed.

Response: The amount of metal varies depending on what metal items are being designated surplus by the departments and can not be used by any other department.

4. How many different sites will there be and there locations?

Response: There are two permanent sites.

5. What happens if the metal pricing changes?

Response: If there is a drastic change in your bid rate compared to the going rate, the vendor will have to continue paying the bid rate or submit a letter to Materials Control detailing the current rate for the metals. The County will have the option to continue with the current vendor or contract with the next lowest bidder for the services.



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6. A) Is there a possibility of dividing the "per pound" to the County by percentage instead of a fixed price? This would make it fair & we'll be sharing the risk in a fair manner.

Response: The County declines to use this method at this time.

B) If not, will there be any renegotiation or adjustment every season or every month?

Response: No

7. A) How will the metals be sorted as the container are being filled?

Response: The vendor will be responsible for sorting all metals.

B) Will they sort in metal types?

Response: No

C) Will they cut certain pieces in the sorting process?

Response: No

8. Will vendors be able to use 45' trailer containers or just roll offs?


Response: The collection containers shall be the forty (40) or forty-five (45) cubic yard, open-top, roll-off, or trailer type.
