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This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and **modifies** the original ITB documents as noted below:

1. "All computers and electronic equipment shall be picked up by the Contractor and delivered to an approved and licensed recycling facility. At the facility, the computers shall be disassembled, reclaimed and prepared for marketing as a raw material in a manner that constitutes recycling as defined by and in strict adherence and compliance to all applicable statutes and mandates of the Federal and State Environmental Protection Agencies, Department of Environmental Quality, U.S. and Virginia Departments of Transportation." Does that mean no equipment is to be tested and resold as working?

Response: Yes

2. Must everything be dismantled?

Response: Yes

3. Is there a value add for a vendor that specializes in resale of remarketable equipment vs strictly scrapping everything, as long as the scrap is handled properly?

Response: No

4. What about testing and selling components removed from whole units such as memory, lcd screens, brackets, processors, cards, cables, and other parts as working?

Response: They test, dismantle, resale and shred in accordance with state laws and regulations.

5. Why is Virginia Department of Transportation referenced, instead of Georgia?

Response: "Virginia" is hereby replaced with "Georgia."

6. What is the estimated quantity to be disposed of during the contract and or per year?

Response: 42,845 lbs per year.

7. What are some example models of equipment to be disposed of?

Response: IBM, Dell, HP, Panasonic, Cisco.

8. If a trailer, instead of an open top container is provided, will the equipment be put into the trailer be on pallets or hand stacked?

Response: Trailers are the method of transportation of electronics. They are palletized and shrink wrapped.

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9. What are the previous bid tabulations?
