Questions concerning 12ITB82129A-DR, Heavy Duty Trucks

1. There are no bid bond required for the submittal of this project; therefore, section 4 (bid bond requirement) pages 41 – 44 as well as from the table of contents. The bid bond requirement has been removed from this bid document in its entirety.
2. The engine and transmission specs limit this bid to GM. Will you consider a Ford bid?
