1. Based on the most recent abstract price for this contract did the amount awarded (\$750,000.00) include the county's reimbursed drug cost, and if not approximately what was the drug reimbursement amount spent under the contract?

Response: The Contract can pay up to \$750,000 to the pharmacy based on prescriptions filled at the outside vendor pharmacy. The Medical Director approves all prescriptions that are sent to the successful vendor pharmacy and monitors monthly utilization.

2. Does this solicitation require the contractor to staff the qualified personnel at the eight county clinical facilities to dispense the prescriptions?

Response: No. The contract is for a vendor pharmacy, not pharmacists.

3. Is there any information that you can provide regarding the contract prescription usage, or drug usage based on the list in the solicitation?

Response: Classes of medications and amounts vary per month based on the needs of the patients. However the amount shall not exceed \$750,000 per year and this is tracked and monitored.
