



Haynes Bridge Rd. Water Line Improvements

Task

Schedules

The Board of Commissioners awarded the project on February 15, 2012. The construction period for the water mains is scheduled for late spring of 2012 and will end in the late fall of 2012.

Fulton County Water Resources will install 1,800 linear feet of new 16" water distribution mains and associated appurtenances on Haynes Bridge Rd. from 1,100' West of GA 400 to 100' east of the northbound Haynes Bridge Rd. entrance ramp of GA 400 in the City of Alpharetta. The purpose of the project is to increase flow capacity and create redundancy in the system with a larger water main and fire hydrants along the route.

Project Benefits

The new pipelines will assist in providing adequate pressures, adequate supply, and improve the overall reliability of the system in these areas. Fire hydrants will be installed along the route to increase fire protection redundancy.

Current Status

Contract awarded to Kemi Construction Co., Inc. on 2-15-12.

Current status as of 6-6-12 : Pre-construction meeting held on 5-16-12.. Project delayed due to GDOT permit for jack and bore under GA 400.
