Project Overview/Purpose

WESTSIDE PARKWAY WATER LINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The scope of this project is to link the 12-inch water main from Windward Parkway to the 12-inch water main at Webb Bridge Road. This will complete the loop and increase the pace of development of the area. It will also increase the system reliability and allow constant water flow during water repair or routine maintenance work.

A small section of the segment has already been installed from the Windward Parkway. The remaining portion to be constructed consists of 2600 linear feet of 12-inch water main which will tie into the existing valve at Webb Bridge Road.

This is part of the overall plan to improve the water distribution system



Current Status

Currently, the design phase is complete and the next step will be the construction phase. The construction phase started on 06/01/2011. The contractor on this project is Kemi Construction Company
