On May 4, 2021, the District Attorney invited Fulton County Sherriff Patrick "Pat" Labat, Atlanta Police Chief Rodney Bryant and the GBI to join her for an interview with Mark Winne of WSB-TV and Christian Boone of the Atlanta Journal-Constitution to discuss the indictment of several alleged members of local affiliates of the Bloods gang, including well-known musician Rayshawn Bennett, A.K.A. "YFN Lucci." The District Attorney explained the unprecedented nature of the 105 count indictment that includes charges brought pursuant to the Georgia RICO and Gang statutes. The District Attorney, Sheriff, Police Chief, and the GBI all explained the serious problem gang violence presents for Metro Atlanta, and plans to fight it with cooperation possible through rebuilt relationships with our criminal justice partners.











Gang Training

On May 14, 2021, FCDA and GGIA hosted a gang training with 60 attendees in the remodeled Board of Commissioners auditorium. The presenters included Ray Ham from the Georgia Gang Investigators Association and the Department of Juvenile Justice, Mark Belknap also with GGIA and APD as well as Derrick McKinney, Darrell Reynolds, and Sharrod Campbell from the Georgia Department of Corrections.

Topics covered included Gang trends and statistics, identifications, charging cases using the Gang statute, and resources available for investigators and prosecutors. At the end of the training, attendees were certified by passing an investigator certification from GGIA in Gang Investigations.

included Mayors and Chiefs of Police from throughout Fulton County.

APD Roll-Call

The Fulton County District Attorney's Office has not implemented a new method of receiving cases from law enforcement in over two decades. Under the new administration, our goal is to streamline the process and eliminate antiquated methods such as facsimile, in exchange for new methods, including cloud storage.



Throughout the Case Intake implementation, we have continuously sought out the input of our law enforcement partners throughout Fulton County. Given how closely intertwined the Case Intake process is with law enforcement, it was a logical next step to go out into the field to speak directly to the officers working in our community. By walking them through the process, in person, and answering any questions they have. The District Attorney's Office aims to increase awareness and investment in these new and exciting developments. We hope that within the next several months we can attend more of these roll calls and speak to the officers directly about the Case Intake unit and its value to the law enforcement and citizens of Fulton County.

Chat & Chew

On Monday, May 25, 2021, the Office of the Fulton County District Attorney held another Chat and Chew for staff. The event was attended by the Program's Division, Operation's Division, Legal Assistants, Records Clerks, as well as our Victim Witness Advocates.

Participants were able to ask questions related to Human Resources and the organization as a whole. Participants were also guided through a PowerPoint presentation on the importance of knowing and understanding Emotional Intelligence in the workplace by our Chief of Programs, Michael Cuffee.
