# Protecting Our Water, Together

The Fulton County Department of Public Works is committed to the conservation and protection of our water resources through strong infrastructure, efficient water usage and engaging environmental education programming. As stewards of the Chattahoochee river, we believe the best way to ensure safe and clean water for future generations tomorrow, is by pledging to lead by example through purposeful action today.

There are a variety of ways for Fulton County residents to participate in the protection of our water resources, many of which begin at home. We encourage all residents to complete an audit of water usage in their homes. Water audits are free, easy, and provide a wealth of knowledge about how much water is used daily. Have you noticed a rise in your water bill? There may be a leak in your home. Participate in one of our Fix-A-Leak workshops. These workshops equip residents with the knowledge of how to identify and stop leaks before they become costly. The Public Education and Outreach team also offers educational videos as part of our Homeowner Series on our website to educate the community on how to conserve water while ensuring quality.

Another way to protect our waterways is to learn about the health of your local creeks and streams by participating in one of the many water quality monitoring workshops through the Georgia Adopt-A-Stream program. This statewide volunteer monitoring program is one of the oldest and largest in the state. Through data collection and purposeful observation, the Georgia Adopt-A-Stream program has led to the identification of potentially harmful pollution spills or bacterial outbreaks.

Did you know that storm drains in your communities lead directly to creeks and streams that feed our drinking water source? This means lawn clippings, trash, and debris trapped in community storm drains can not only cause major flooding issues in your neighborhood, but can impact water quality as well. A great way to tackle this issue is to participate in one of our stormwater education and storm drain stenciling workshops. These workshops are designed to educate the public on the importance and required care of storm drains in local communities.

Consider participating in one of our community stream cleanups. Illegal dumping of trash and litter in our waterways is one of the biggest problems for Fulton County residents. Not only is the trash unsightly, but it impacts the health of our creeks and streams, which support our drinking water source, the Chattahoochee River. The public education and outreach team is committed to addressing this issue by helping Fulton County residents organize stream cleanups in their neighborhoods.
