To highlight to the litter problem in our communities and to encourage environmental stewardship, participants will create and submit original artwork by using recycled items.



SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Artwork must be original and created by students. All entries must be created entirely by using recycled materials. NO paint, marker, or crayons may be used.

Glue, aluminum or copper wire, and **colored** tape may be used to bind your art piece.



SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Entries must be either: Sculpture or Visual Art (collage, textured print) Submission may not exceed 2ft x 2ft x 2ft.

One entry may be submitted per student. **NO group work.** Artwork must highlight litter as an environmental issue.



WHERE DO I SUBMIT?

All participants must take a photo of their artwork and submit it as an attachment to **tinyurl.com/RAC2026** by 2/26/26. Late submissions will not be considered.

WHAT ARE THE PRIZES?

All winners will receive a gift certificate and framed photograph of their artwork.
All artwork remains the property of the Fulton County
Department of Public Works and may be used in promotional materials and/or other media.
All winners will be notified by April 1st by telephone or email.
