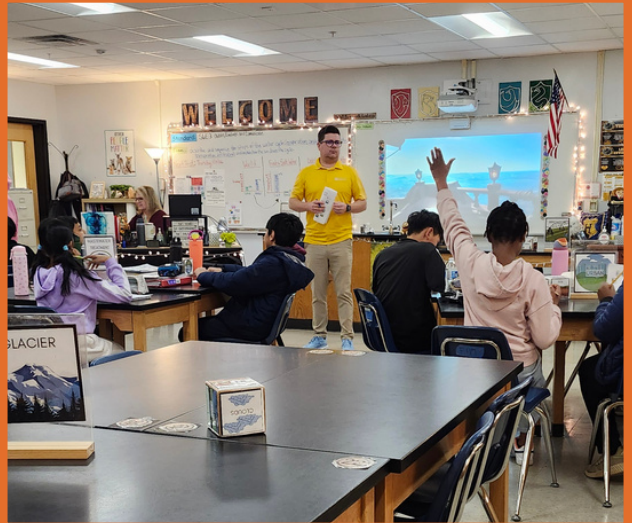

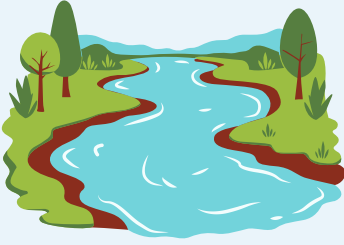

Fashion a River

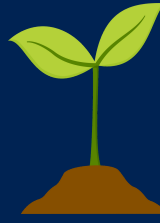


Kindergarten GSE: SKL1

First Grade GSE: S1L1

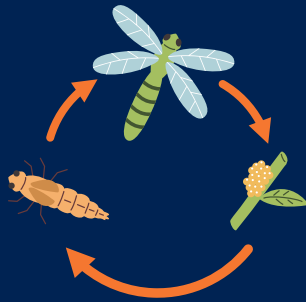
Students will create their own model of a plant, showcasing each of its parts and their important functions.

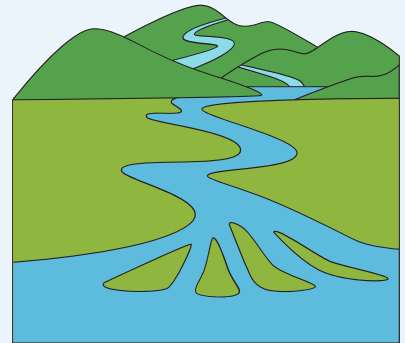
Life Cycles

Paper Watershed

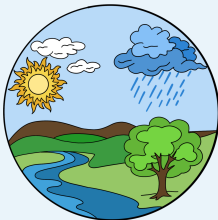


Third Grade GSE: S3L2

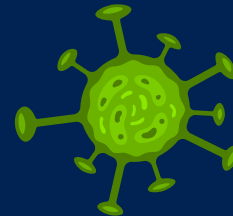


Fourth Grade GSE: S4E3
