In the month of October, we successfully completed all training classes. Advance Voting for the **November 4<sup>th</sup> PSC/ Municipal & Special Election** began on **October 14-31**, operating **24** AV locations.

Advance Voting for the November **18<sup>th</sup> Special Election for Senate District 35** on **October 27-November 14**, operating **3** AV locations.

Overall, Advance Voting is progressing smoothly as we continue to provide ongoing support to all Advance Voting locations for both elections.

After the completion of advance voting, we will be engaging in our continual post-election activities. These activities include reconciliation which is an audit of the EV location operations for compliance with state and county policies and procedures.

Our next focus is geared toward the 2025 Runoff Election Events.

In October, the election division worked on the following items:

#### Internal Operations:

- Coordinate with municipalities regarding contests for the November Statewide & Municipal Election Ballot.
- Maintaining and adding contests in GARVIS for the November Election.
- Received Ballot project and coordinated Ballot Proofing for the 2025 Election.
- Formulated and Ordered Provisional, Emergency, and Sample ballot Allocation for the November 4, 2025, Election.
- Formulated all signage requirements for the Statewide Municipal Election.

## ELECTION DAY OPERATIONS

Recruited **1,106** Poll Workers for November 4, 2025. General and Special Election. Election Day and training started on September 23, 2025, and will conclude on November 1, 2025. To date we have trained **1070** Poll Workers.

## FINANCE

**DATE OF REPORT:** 10/29/2025

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

We have completed the draft 2026 Elections and Operating budget. The Elections budget for 2026 includes four election cycles. The draft 2026 budgets were submitted in September 2025 to the Finance department. We had a budget review meeting with the Fulton County budget committee in October 2025. The draft summary budget data for 2026 is noted below. In November 2025, the complete Fulton County budget for all departments for 2026 will be presented to the Fulton County Board of Commissioners.

We have funded the Senate District 21 special election for August 26, 2025 and the Senate District 21 run-off election for September 23, 2025, from the Election Department's underruns on the June and July 2025 elections.

We have requested funding for the Senate District 35 special election for November 18, 2025, and the possible Senate District 35 special election run-off for December 16, 2025. The Finance department has recently approved the funding budget request.

The Financial Systems manager has continued to update the 2025 budget reporting. We have updated the budgets for November 4, 2025, and December 2, 2025, elections. We have prepared a budget for November 18, 2025, Special called election for State Senate 35 and for the possible special run-off election on December 16, 2025. We have completed a budget for August 26, 2025, special called election for State Senate 21 and for the special run-off election on September 23, 2025.

We are continuing to process the vendor invoices for expenses incurred for 2025 elections work.

We continue to review the budget to actual costs for the 2025 Election cycles. We are generating both the Accounting and Purchase order reports to review our costs and to stay within our budget.

- **Technical Support:** Trained and assigned Advance Voting technicians, managed ongoing technical support throughout the Advance Voting period, and coordinated planning for Election Day operations and tabulation support.

**2. Senate District 35 Special Election**

System Specialists performed L&A testing for the Senate District 35 Special Election, provided technical support during Advance Voting, and coordinated planning for Election Day operations and tabulation.

- Completed preparing the Election Day Supply Boxes for the November 4, 2025, PSC / Municipal General Election.
- Started preparing the Election Day Supply bags for November 4, 2025, PSC / Municipal General Election.
- Completed Advance Voting Equipment and Supply deliveries for both the November 4, 2025, PSC / Municipal General Election, and November 18, 2025, SS35 Special Election.
- Started Election Day Equipment and Supply deliveries for November 4, 2025, PSC / Municipal General Election.
- Provided logistical and supply support to all the Advance Voting polling locations for the November 4, 2025, PSC / Municipal General Election, and the November 18, 2025, SS35 Special Election by sending any supplies or other assistance as requested by the polling locations.
- Installed required precinct change signage at required locations.
- Provided absentee ballot drop box support by picking up any absentee ballots dropped into the 7 absentee ballot drop boxes and transferring them to the Absentee Ballot Division during November 4, 2025, PSC / Municipal General Election
- The staff continued to conduct day-to-day logistics operations for the Elections Warehouse.

## VOTER EDUCATION

**DATE OF REPORT:** October 28, 2025

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

In October, the Voter Education and Outreach team continued its focus on civic engagement holidays and outreach to senior centers, colleges, universities, and municipalities. The team concentrated on promoting National Voter Education Week and National Vote Early Day. The VEO manager also sent emails to every mayor, councilmember, and city clerk at the start of early voting to ensure they had the latest flyers and informational materials for the municipal election and to gather details on upcoming events in municipalities where the VEO team may need to provide voter education. Additionally, for the November 18th special election for Senate District 35, the VEO manager emailed elected officials with constituents in Senate District 35 with the election collateral for promotional purposes. In an effort to assist voters who may be confused by the overlap of early voting for the PSC Election and the special election for Senate District 35, the VEO team set up a voter education table at the three overlapping early voting locations to answer questions and help voters.

The VEO manager led an Election Academy session for citizens interested in learning more about the Elections Department and also conducted the Fulton County Citizens University.

The VEO manager stays informed and participates in all sessions of the GA House of Representatives Blue-Ribbon Study Committee on elections, providing the Leadership team with updates on proposed legislation affecting elections next year. The final meeting was held on Thursday, October 16, 2025, in Americus, Georgia. The VEO manager also continues to monitor all GA Election Board meetings.

The VEO manager also serves as a member of the GAVERO Legislative Committee, which recently met to determine legislative priorities for the year. The information from the meeting has been shared with the Leadership team.

The VEO team continues to plan events and will continue to reach out to schools, community groups, nonprofits, and government officials to organize future activities across the county.
