  - > East Roswell Branch Library
  - Park Place at Newtown
  - Roswell City Hall
  - > South Fulton Service Center
- 3,742 Unofficial EV Results
- 150 Absentee by Mail received and 9 Rejections before the polls closed

Mr. Barron informed all ballot rejections were no signature

# #4- CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS: DECEMBER 3, 2019, GENERAL MUNICIPAL RUNOFF ELECTION

**Mr.** Barron informed the Board of Gay v. Shavala Moore, Barron, et al. Mrs. Gay filed a petition to contest the November 2019 General Municipal Election in the City of College Park; therefore, the judge assigned will not allow **BRE** to certify the Runoff election at this time
