#### #3 - DISCUSSION OF DECEMBER 1, 2020, GENERAL/SPECIAL RUNOFF ELECTION

#### Mr. Barron updated the BRE:

- 10,000+ Ballots cast
- 146 Absentee By Mail
- Challenging Election due to two check-ins within a polling location
- Between the two races 44 precincts were overlapping
- Overlapping during Early Voting
  - The 3 day week of Thanksgiving
  - two check-ins were required by law, separate databases

**Mr. Barron** mentioned no concerns regarding certifying the December 1<sup>st</sup> Election during the regular **BRE** Meeting on December 11<sup>th</sup>.

**Mr. Barron** informed the **BRE** that ballots were supposed to be mailed out by **Secretary Of State's office** on November 23<sup>rd</sup> and ballots were not mailed until today. The **DRE** planned to have Runbeck mail their ballots until December 14<sup>th</sup> and the **DRE** will begin thereafter.
