#1- APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Chairperson Cooney entertained a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was made by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Ms. Nuriddin and carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.

#2- COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC RESPONSE

Greg Clay, a candidate City of Atlanta, District 3, requested clarity on absentee ballots included and excluded.

#3- CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS: SPECIAL ELECTIONS ON MARCH 19, 2019

<u>Chairperson Cooney entertained a motion to certify the election results for City of Atlanta, Council District 3. The motion was made by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Burge.</u>

Chairperson Cooney requested clarity on all provisional and absentee ballots

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Mr. Barron stated there were 6 Provisional Ballots received on Election day; accepted 2 and rejected 4 (1- unregistered voter, 1- Out of county voter {Gwinnett resident} and 2- voters out of district). Mr. Barron stated that of the Absentee Ballots 3 were rejected due to lack of signatures

Chairperson Cooney inquired if all voters received notice of their voting status

- Mr. Barron stated all letters were mailed to both absentee by mail and provisional voters
- Mr. Burge inquired about how many Absentee Ballots were received
- **Mr. Jones** indicated that the **DRE** received 46 for the City of Atlanta, City Council-District 3 and 2 for the City of Hapeville, Alderman At Large
- Ms. Nuriddin inquired about statistics the BRE received on Election night
- **Mr. Jones** informed the **BRE** of the previous report received which indicated when an application for an absentee ballot was received, processed, and rejected.
- Mr. Johnson inquired about the DRE receiving any absentee ballots after the deadline
- Mr. Jones stated yes, the DRE received an absentee ballot today in the mail

Chairperson Cooney asked **Mr. Barron** was it his certification and testimony that the election results presented an accurate count of all the votes cast in the Special Election held on March 19, 2019

- Mr. Barron answered yes

The motion carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.
