Election Central Move: All voting equipment was securely moved from our Election Preparation Center and Phillip Lee Warehouse to Election Central. The Information Systems staff scanned all voter equipment and other critical assets from the Phillip Lee warehouse and Elections Preparation Center and our inventory system was used as the tracking device from its current location to the new warehouse. As the voting equipment and critical assets were delivered at Election Central, the items were received and scanned and placed in its distinct location using the inventory system.

Server Relocation: The election management server and all its workstations were relocated from the Election Preparation Center to the Election Central Warehouse accompanied by a Fulton County Police escort. It was placed in its secured location which is the see-through server cage in the elections warehouse. The server was then connected and is properly working.

SOS Server Testing: The Secretary of State Center for Election Systems reported to the new warehouse and conducted compliance and acceptance testing on the server and all workstations and scanners connected to the server. Testing was successful.

The month of July was focused on back-to-school outreach events across the county. The VEO team utilized Deputy Registrars to assist with multiple back-to-school events.

The VEO team also spent the month of July conducting outreach to all of the Fulton County Libraries to schedule education sessions during August and September; all but three libraries have been confirmed and scheduled.

The Voter Education and Outreach team will begin outreach to senior centers across the county to plan for absentee applications and TVIC requests once applications become available on August 21. The VEO team is also contacting colleges and universities within Fulton County to host voter education events to ensure new students are registered to vote and educated on the upcoming municipal election in November.

The VEO manager will begin outreach to the municipalities across the county once qualifying is over to promote and bring awareness to the election and education to the residents relating to redistricting.

The VEO team continues to assist the registration department in processing DDS applications and scanning voter registration cards. The VEO team also continues to conduct Deputy Registrar Training for all new staff members.

The VEO manager is assisting in planning for the new elections central grand opening and will handle all RSVPs and tours of the facility. The VEO team has updated all collateral material for the Municipal election cycle and will begin utilizing them for upcoming events.
