## FINANCE

**DATE OF REPORT:** 03/01/2024

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

The Fulton County Board of Commissioners (BOC) has issued the final approval of the 2024 Elections and Operations budgets. The 2024 Elections budget was reduced to \$34 million. This is a \$1 million reduction to our elections budget. We have adjusted our Elections budget for the \$1 million reduction. The Finance department has provided the 2024 Elections and Operations funding in the AMS accounting system.

The BOC approved 2024 Elections budget is funding for the 1<sup>st</sup> four election cycles for 2024. The Finance department's plan is to fund the December 2024 General run-off election, if needed, from the overall Fulton County underruns.

The Financial Systems manager has managed the two temporary staffing agencies to onboard temporary employees and to request billing reports for the temporary staff. We continue to meet with the temporary staffing agencies to coordinate their recruiting efforts to fill open temporary positions.

At the end of February 2024, we received some of the new 2024 Purchase orders which will allow us to process the backlog of 2024 invoices for the vendors where a purchase order was issued. Finance has developed work around procedures that results in our team having a longer process to complete the processing of vendor invoices, therefore please note that vendor payments will be delayed due to the cybersecurity issues that occurred.

The remaining balances of the 2023 November and December municipal elections budget were rolled over into 2024 to fund the rest of the 2023 municipal election expenses. We are tracking the 2023 budget to actual costs analysis to ensure we adhere to the municipal election budget. We are continuing to process vendor invoices received for the 2023 municipal elections. We are following up with vendors who have not submitted their 2023 invoices to us.

### PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

**March 12<sup>th</sup> Presidential Preference Primary Election:** The Information Systems staff begin preparation for the March 12<sup>th</sup> Presidential Preference Primary Election. The main items in preparation are listed below.

- **Logic & Accuracy Testing** – Logic & Accuracy Testing begin on January 16<sup>th</sup> and will continue through March 7<sup>th</sup>. The Information Systems staff started and continue to conduct Logic & Accuracy Testing and program all equipment for Election Day. The Information Systems staff will conduct Logic & Accuracy testing and complete updates on all Poll Pads used at Election Day sites and have these Poll Pads completed by March 10<sup>th</sup>.
- **Technical Support** – The Information Systems staff will provide technical support for Advance Voting which starts on February 19<sup>th</sup> and ends on March 8<sup>th</sup>. Systems Specialists will also provide technical support for all Election Day sites on Election Day, March 12<sup>th</sup>.
- **Sunday Pick Up** – Provide Poll Pads, seals, precinct supply bags, and precinct binders to the Poll Manager for Election Day on Sunday, March 10<sup>th</sup>.
- **Election Night** – Closing out advance voting tabulators. Uploading memory cards from each Advanced Voting and Election Day precinct and tabulate. Display results and send reports to the SOS.
- **Post-Election** – Receive in all voting equipment that was used in the Presidential Preference Primary Election. Conduct final tabulation and prepare reports for certification.

## VOTER EDUCATION

**DATE OF REPORT:** Feb 29, 2024

### **PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

In February, The Voter Education and Outreach team focused on continued outreach to seniors across the county, outreach to high schools, libraries, and recreation centers. The VEO manager sent a letter to every library and every recreation center in the county. Included in the correspondence were the updated voter education materials for the current election cycle. The VEO manager also sent correspondence to every county mayor, city council member, and city clerk, alerting them of the beginning of early voting, the locations, and updated collateral for the 2024 election cycle. She will continue outreach to the cities to conduct events leading up to the General Primary as many residents across the county will have new districts and education will be essential to lessen confusion.

The VEO manager continued the partnership with the High Museum of Art by conducting outreach events at the facility to promote the 2024 election cycle. The VEO manager is also conducting Deputy registrar training and working with Deputy Registrars to conduct voter registration drives across the county. The VEO manager also worked with the City of Atlanta's mayor's office to contact the various high rises across the city to schedule voter education activities. The VEO team has begun outreach with the colleges and universities in the county to start scheduling outreach events on all the campuses while promoting the early voting outreach schedule. The VEO team has begun planning events at all the Fulton County libraries to organize outreach events at their facilities.

The VEO Manager continues to meet with the external affairs team to discuss collateral for the 2024 election cycle and continues to work to coordinate any request for interviews. The focus for March will be finalizing the head of the household mailer that will go out to ensure all voters are aware of the general primary and redistricting that impacts them. The VEO team is also scheduling events in the areas indicated on the Carter Center Report that need more Voter Education as those areas were affected by the newly drawn maps.

The VEO manager participates in legislative meetings as needed to discuss all bills introduced that impact the elections department and attends committee meetings to listen to the hearings on all election bills. The VEO manager also serves on the legislative committee for GAVERO. In February, the VEO manager attended the Fulton delegation meeting to discuss the various election bills. The VEO Manager also attended CERA Course 3 as a part of the continued effort to become a certified election official through the Election Center.

The VEO team will continue to contact schools, communities, non-profit organizations, and government officials regarding scheduling future events. We are developing ongoing outreach opportunities with various groups to strengthen our impact in the community.
