Fulton County Elections Statement: Polling Place Selection

The Fulton County Department of Registration and Elections partners with a wide range of facilities within each precinct—including religious institutions, cultural and recreation centers, libraries, and other community spaces—to provide convenient and accessible voting locations. While the Department collaborates with organizations representing diverse faiths and cultures, cultural, national, or religious affiliation is not a factor in site selection.

Polling locations are evaluated using consistent logistical criteria, including proximity to voter residences, facility capacity, and ADA accessibility, to meet community needs and uphold the integrity, neutrality, and security of the voting process.

Proposed polling relocations are shared with the impacted municipality and commissioner district for review and feedback prior to consideration by the Fulton County Board of Registration & Elections for approval.

Fulton County offers multiple voting options to ensure accessibility and convenience. Voters may cast a ballot at any Advance Voting location, request and return an absentee-by-mail ballot, or vote at their assigned Election Day polling location. Voters are notified of polling location changes well in advance to allow time to plan and select their preferred voting method.
