Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. We are a new nonprofit, without a physical location. When we attempted to register with Sam.gov, we were denied because we currently utilize a virtual office. Is there a work around to this requirement?
  - a. You must have a physical location to register an entity in SAM.gov. P.O. Boxes and standard virtual/forwarding mailboxes are not accepted. See the [SAM.gov Entity Registration Checklist](#) for more information. With that being said what address is being used for the non-profits bank account, legal documents, and state and IRS designation? The address used for these may be used as the non-profit's physical location in the sam.gov registration. The guidelines state that for entity's physical address must meet the following guidelines: "1) Business is consistently conducted at this address or 2) Business records are securely kept at this address."
  
2. If we are a PSH project transitioning to a TH project and our project's fiscal year is 9/1-8/31, would the estimated project date for this application be 9/1/27-8/31/28?
  - a. Yes, the FY 2026 NOFO states that the start date of a transition grant will be immediately following the end date of the previous grant term.
  
3. It was reported to us that the New Project Budget workbook sent out to LOI applicants and posted on the website had several tabs that were unlocked. This can cause applicants to accidentally override the auto calculation formulas in the excel document. The new workbook will be posted on the [Fulton County CoC webpage](#).
