
2023 ART CALENDAR



Submission Guidelines

All Guidelines must be followed in order for submitted artwork to be qualified for judging:

- Drawing must show ways in which we use water or ways to protect our water resources.
- Drawing must be original and created by students. Computerized or digital art will not be accepted.
- One drawing per student.
- Drawing must be landscape orientation 8.5 X 11 in on white paper. See example above.
- Fill the entire page with a bright and colorful drawing.
- All drawings must include a title with correct spelling and/or punctuation.
- All drawings must include student name, grade level, and school on the back of each submission.
- All fields on the student entry form must be complete, please print legibly.
- Paperclip completed entry form to your drawing. Please do not staple or fold your artwork.

CONTEST

Fulton County K-12 students are invited to create and submit original artwork for this the 2023 Art Calendar Contest. The goal of this year's theme, **Water Connects Us**, is to promote awareness of our most precious and limited resource, water. By asking each student to create an original piece of art, we aim to inspire the next generation of environmental stewards to get involved in the protection of our water resources.

From the submitted artwork, 13 pieces will be featured in our 2023 Art Calendar. **One Grand prize cover winner and 12 monthly winners will be selected.** All winners will receive a gift certificate and copies of the calendar. 
